- 1. The OC float will be on 2nd Avenue East for loading at 6:30 PM. Our spot is #14, which is staked and easy to find.
- 2. Be sure to sign your child/ren IN upon arrival and OUT after the parade. You can pick up your child/ren on 3rd Avenue East between S.4th and 5th.
- 3. The float is an open trailer, so dress warmly with coats, hats, gloves, etc.
- 4. TK 4th graders will ride the float and 5th 8th will walk the route beside the float.
- 5. 5th 8th graders will hand out candy (NOTE: candy cannot be thrown/tossed as per parade organizers).
